



## INVITATION FOR BIDS

PROPOSED INTERIOR WORK FOR

THE GROUND FLOOR OFFICE AREA OF “MEHEWARA PIYASA” AT KIRULA ROAD,  
COLOMBO 05

- 1 **The Chairman of Consultative Procurement Committee (CPCD) on behalf of the Commissioner General of Labour** now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Proposed Interior Work For The Ground Floor Office Area Of “Mehewara Piyasa” At Kirula Road, Colombo 05** as described below and approximately estimated to cost **LKR 6 Million** (excluding VAT).

*The Works consists of fabricate supply and install of special interior items, furnishing Proposed Interior Work For The Ground Floor Office Area Of “Mehewara Piyasa” At Kirula Road, Colombo 05. The Intended Completion Date of the Works shall be 126 Days from the Start Date.*

- 2 Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding Procedure.
- 3 To be eligible for the Contract award,
  - **The successful bidder shall not have been blacklisted and shall have a valid business registration in Sri Lanka for at least five (05) years.**
  - **The successful bidder shall have CIDA (Construction Industry Development Authority) Grading SP4 or above in the field of furniture, fittings and equipments.**
  - **The successful bidder shall be accredited and registered under ISO9001.**

Documentary evidence, supporting the Bidder's experience and track record shall be established with the Bid.

- 4 Qualification requirements to qualify for contract award include:
  - Average annual turnover in the last five (05) years shall be at least LKR 15 million.
  - Experience in successful completion of at least one project in Sri Lanka with extensive and integrated interior furnishing and architectural fit-outs for value not less than LKR 25 million within last five years.
  - The minimum amount of liquid assets net of other contractual commitments and exclusive of any advance payment which may be made under this Contract, shall be not less than LKR 9 million.

- 5 Interested bidders may obtain further information from **Finance Division** and inspect the bidding documents free of charge at the same address **from 01 February 2022 until 21 February 2022 from 0900 hrs to 1500 hrs** during working days.

- 6 A complete set of Bidding Documents (Except Volume 1) in English language may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to **Finance Division** from **01 February 2022** until **21 February 2022** from **0900 hrs** to **1500 hrs** during working days upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Two Thousand Sri Lankan Rupees (LKR 2,000.00)**. The method of payment will be cash.
- 7 Pre bid meeting will be held at **1000 hrs on 14 February 2022** and a site visit will be held on **same day** after the pre bid meeting at the **Auditorium, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Labour Secretariat Building, Colombo 05**
- 8 Bids shall be delivered in duplicate to the address below or shall be deposited in the Tender box placed at the address below on or before **1400 hrs on 22 February 2022**. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened soon after closing in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend.
- 9 Bids shall be valid up to **24 May 2022** (*91 Days after the date of Bid opening*).
- 10 All bids shall be accompanied by a "Bid-Security", of **Sri Lankan Rupees Fifty Eight Thousand (LKR 58,000.00)** obtained from a commercial bank operating in Sri Lanka approved by the Central Bank of Sri Lanka in the form of an unconditional and on demand guarantee and shall be valid up to **21 June 2022** (119 days after the date of Bid opening).
- 11 If any bidder wishes to submit bids for several packages of the same block or any other blocks of this project, the bidder shall establish the qualification/ eligibility criteria required under each contract separately, if not the bidder will not be qualified for the award of more than one bid.
- 12 In addition to Item 11 of above, if any bidder was already being selected/is working as a contractor in any of the packages of the block/s of this project, the bidder shall establish his financial and technical requirements under specification/ eligibility criteria exclusively for this bidding package. If not, the bidder will not be qualified for the award of this bid.
- 13 Bidders shall present the registration certificate under the Public Contract Act No.3 of 1987 before purchasing the bidding documents.
- 14 Bidders are advised to inform in writing, to **The Chairman of Consultative Procurement Committee (CPCD)** the name and the NIC/ Passport Number of the individual who is participating at the bid opening at least prior to three (03) working days of the bid opening.
