"Child Labour" means engagement of a child below 14 years of age in any work with the intent of receiving "Labour"

All adults should accept that the child is an important asset to a family, society and the country at large, who is essentially in need of education blended with love, kindness and equality.

Under the provisions of the Employment of Women, Young pesons & Children Act. No. 47 of 1956 enforced by the Department of Labour, employment of a child below 14 years of age is an offence punishable in a court of law.

Pre is no doubt that even you would have observed on many occasions where our children - deprived of education, being employed in numerous trades with callous regard to laws, regulations and conventions.

Even today, children are employed in the residences of people of all social strata, and also at hotels, garages, carpentry workshops, coir mills, rubber and coconut estates and farms of percent and poultry.

It is your responsibility

- To understand that child labour is an offence.
- Create awareness of it, among your friends and everyone in your social level, with whom you associate in the society
 And
- Extend your cooperation to law enforcement officers to bring the offenders before the law.


